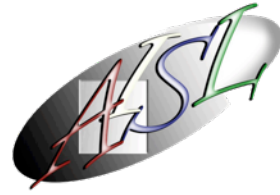

Emergency Plans

AISL has plans to address various types of emergencies that may impact the school. These varying types of emergency situations are shared with students and staff and are practiced regularly. Please know that in the event of an emergency, gates will be locked and parents, nannies, and other outside guests may experience a wait, either inside our outside, until security is given the all clear signal to resume normal pedestrian traffic.

If you are inside the school when an emergency occurs, staff will direct you to the proper muster point for parents and visitors, depending on the type of emergency. Your assistance will be appreciated in making sure teachers and students have clear pathways to get to their assigned locations. Please move quickly to the location staff direct you to, and do not go with your child or remove your child from the teacher's care if you are in the building. Teachers have been directed to proceed with specific plans, and the less they have to worry about regarding additional people or an alteration from practiced plans, the safer your children will be. Thank you for your understanding and support in this matter.

Emergency Dismissal Procedures

If the back gate is able to be safely accessed, bus students of the Consulate, Chevron, Mobil, Shell, Total, and Schlumberger will be escorted to their busses in the back or a waiting area near the bus pick up if the busses have not yet arrived. If the back gate cannot be used, the school will be in communication with these companies to arrange for alternate pick-up locations.

Single-family student pick-ups and other company pick-ups will be from the front gate. Please look for signs posted designating the age level of the student to be picked up, and wait in the appropriate line. If you have more than one age level child (elementary, middle school, high school), you can wait in one line. When you reach the front of the line, you will be asked for identification and to sign a form releasing your child to you. A "runner" will get your child and bring him/her to the front to meet you. Please note: Only individuals authorized on the Student Information/Release Card will be authorized to pick up students and ALL individuals will be required to show identification, which will be recorded on the pick-up sheet.
