PURPOSE

The purpose of granting scholarships to Nigerian children is:

1. To give an American-type education to those Nigerian children whose parents desire it for them with specific regard to their socio-economic status,
2. To give American children an opportunity to know the children in the land where they presently are living.

NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS PER FAMILY

There is to be no limit or prejudice as to the number of scholarships given in one family. Selection shall be based entirely on merit and need.

RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIPS

AI SL is committed to maintaining any student accepted into the school on a scholarship basis as long as the student maintains the standards of the school. Scholarships will be reviewed yearly by the Scholarship Committee, the committee will take into consideration the following:

1. Academic work
2. Knowledge of and proficiency in English
3. Social adjustment

The student shall be considered for scholarship renewal if, in the judgement of the committee, he/she is performing, both academically and socially, at least up to the average level of the class or if in the foreseeable future, he/she will perform at that level.

NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The total number of scholarships shall not exceed ten percent of the total enrollment of the school. These scholarships are given by the U.S. Government, private businesses and AISL.
