Registration

Regular registration starts **Wednesday, November 16** and ends **Wednesday, November 23 by 11am**. Late registration starts **Monday, November 28** and ends **Friday, December 2**. There will be no late add-ins after Friday, December 2. Students must register for non-fee based activities and/or pay for fee-based activities through the business office before they can participate in the AISL After-School Activities program.

How do I register my child?

The **Registration Form (attached)** should be completed and returned to the AISL Business Office with correct payment for **FEE-ACTIVITIES**. The AISL Business Office will provide a registration/payment receipt. **PRINT LEGIBLY** when completing the form. *Payment is due when you register.*

Do I give money to instructors?

Payments for fee activities are to be made in the business office. Some tournaments, special competitions, or events taking place at AISL may be free to AISL students. Students who wish to participate in private lessons will be given a slip by the lesson coach indicating how many lessons and the amount. This slip is to be given to the business office for payment.
